Sample Translated Sentences Containing 'quitarse'

*Quítese sus zapatos*  
Take off your shoes

*quitarse la camisa*  
to take off one's shirt

*quitarse las medias*  
to take off one's stockings / socks

*Se quita el sombrero.*  
She takes off her hat.

*¿Se le quita el dolor después de descansar?*  
Does the pain go away after you rest?

*quitarse el sombrero*  
to take off one's hat

*¿Se le quitó el dolor después de tomar la nitroglicerina?*  
Did your pain go away after taking nitroglycerin?

*Si no se le quita el dolor después de tomar tres pastillas, regrese al hospital.*  
If the pain does not go away after taking three pills, you should return to the hospital.

*¿Ya se te quitó el dolor de muelas?*  
Has your toothache gone away?

*¿Se le quitó el dolor?*  
Has your pain gone away?

*Quitarse los zapatos / Descalzarse*  
to take off one's shoes

*Ellos siempre se quitan los zapatos al entrar a la casa.*  
They always take their shoes off when entering the house.

*Se les pide a los viajeros que se quiten los zapatos en el aeropuerto.*  
Travelers are asked to take off their shoes at the airport.

*¿Le pides a tus visitas que se quiten los zapatos?*  
Do you ask your guests to take off their shoes?

*Ellos siempre le piden a sus visitas que se quiten los zapatos.*  
They always ask their guests to take off the shoes.

*No tienen que quitarse los zapatos.*  
You (pl) don't have to take off your shoes.

*¿Te importa si me quito los zapatos?*  
Do you mind if I take my shoes off?
